Dungeon Delve IV: Crypt of the Devil-Lich (Location changed!)

Our GMs are ready, and we're happy to oblige you with lots of crunchy death! Come support EGG in our first fundraiser of 2006!

- **The Time:** Saturday, January 7, 2006 - Be there between 10:30am-11am, the delve starts promptly at noon!
- **The Place:** **Noble Romans at Ross Center, corner of Boeke and Washington.** Come prepared to buy food! Please do not attempt to bring outside food to a restaurant.
- **The Entry Fee:** \$5 per person. If you die, \$1 resurrects your PC immediately upon death with refreshed equipment, otherwise, you rise again at the start of the next tournament round (end of the level).
- **The Rules:** Three-round tournament, 6-man team tables. Characters will be provided. 15th level pregens, every table of 6 gets the same characters. Teams accrue points for completing objectives in the dungeon. At the end of 3 timed rounds, points are tallied, and the highest team total wins! Yes, you can distribute the PCs as you wish. The party consists of a paladin, a monk, a ranger/rogue, a rogue/bard, a fighter, and a wizard.
- **The Prize:** Half of the total entry fees!
